INFORMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL COMPETITORS TRAVELING TO CONNAUGHT

Bringing Firearms/Ammunition into Canada: All non-Canadian residents bringing firearms and/or ammunition into Canada are required to complete a Form 5589 "Non-Resident Firearms Declaration", which is to be presented at your port of entry into Canada. Forms can/should be completed, ***in triplicate***, ahead of time but ***left unsigned*** until you are with a Border Services officer. There is a fee of \$25 for a non-resident possession license which will cover firearms that are deemed to be non-restricted (i.e. bolt action rifles, shotguns, etc.). If you are bringing a restricted firearm (i.e. most AR pattern semi-automatic rifles, handguns, etc.) please contact the RCMP to arrange for an Authorization to Transport (ATT).

Bringing Components into Canada: Reloading components must be declared at your port of entry into Canada, and are subject to a limit of 5000 cases, 5000 primers, and a total of 8kg of smokeless powder in containers of no more than 4kg. Loaded ammunition has a personal exemption limit of 5000 cartridges. At this time we are working to secure a space at Connaught Ranges where handloading of ammunition can take place.
