Notes:

1. All competitors are eligible for Open Class awards.
2. Only CAF/RCMP competitors using issue firearms are eligible for CAF/RCMP awards. Competitors registered as CAF/RCMP are not permitted to fire personal firearms in competitions.
3. Tyro is a competitor who has not previously competed in a National Service Conditions Championship of the DCRA, CAFSAC or other international service conditions competition. Only a Canadian citizen may compete as a Tyro.
4. Wounded Warrior Aggregate is open to all those who choose not to participate in the run-downs.
5. All non-Canadians must compete in the Open and Senior classifications.
6. No charge for the 3 Gun Championship. Open to any competitor entered in all three disciplines. Must be in the same Division throughout.
7. **Entry fees will only be refunded in exceptional circumstances. Refunded entries will incur a 20% booking fee and there may be some delay in processing (after competition season).**

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Notes for changes/amendments in NSCC 2019.

Awards General

HPS Cross - The DCRA will present a special HPS award to any competitor who scores a possible (HPS) in any individual match during NSCC. Competitors who score more than one HPS may purchase extra awards (one for each possible) from the DCRA at a cost to be posted during the Championships.

Awards Service Pistol

There have been some changes to Aggregates, Team awards and Falling plates. Please check Program Book for details.

Awards Service Rifle

There have been several changes to Aggregates (Snaps / Rapids / Rundown / 200m / 300m / 500m / Grand Agg) with 2nd and 3rd placing for each division and Team awards. **Only Aggregate awards will be presented**, individual match certificates may be picked up at the DCRA office outside of awards ceremony. Please check Program Book for details.

Wounded Warrior Aggregate is available for those who choose not to participate in the run-downs.

Rules

IAW Rules 5.05.10 and 6.05.10 - Any communications device capable of communicating privately is forbidden on the firing point and in the butts. This includes communication capable weather stations.

New in 2019 - Service Conditions 'Trial' Class

Service rifle – Competitor using .223/5.56mm

- Ammunition must be less than 69 grains and shall be FMJ;
- No open or polymer tipped projectiles;
- Open sights or optical sights which are not greater than 4X;
- Only flash suppressors (flash hider) are permitted. Compensators or Muzzle Brakes are not permitted;
- Trigger weight shall be in accordance with rule 5.03 6.a (2kg for semi auto / 1.5kg for bolt);
- No adjustable match triggers;
- Competitors agree to an inspection by the match committee to confirm firearm is compliant;
- A competitor must have at least five rounds available at any time for inspection to confirm projectile type/weight.

Service rifle – Competitor using .308/7.62mm

- Ammunition must be less than 160 grains and shall be FMJ;
- No open or polymer tipped projectiles;
- Open sights or optical sights which are not greater than 4X;
- Only flash suppressors (flash hider) are permitted. Compensators or Muzzle Brakes are not permitted;
- Trigger weight shall be in accordance with rule 5.03 6.a (2kg for semi auto / 1.5kg for bolt);
- No adjustable match triggers;
- Competitors agree to an inspection by the match committee to confirm firearm is compliant;
- A competitor must have at least five rounds available at any time for inspection to confirm projectile type/weight.

Precision Rifle

- Must shoot .308/7.62mm;
- Must shoot ammo less than 178 grain;
- Competitors agree to an inspection by the match committee to confirm firearm is compliant;
- A competitor must have at least five rounds available at any time for inspection to confirm projectile type/weight.

Match Changes & Notes:

Service Pistol

- Matches 25/35 will now use the DCRA 'Save the Hostage' target
- Rule 7.24.a - MilCun Body target scoring is now V - Orange Dot; 5 - Black Dot; 4, 3, 2 on the remainder of the target
- Rule 7.24.b - Centre of Mass target scoring is now 5, 4, 3 & 2
- Operationally relevant red-dot sights and muzzle breaks are allowed for 2019 (NO COMPETITION RACE GUNS)
- Falling plates match - Targets are now 6 inches (circular in diameter) polymer targets

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Precision Rifle

- Match 60 - Will now use the DCRA 'Save the Hostage' target
- Match 63 - Target will now be a Fig 12 (300M) and scoring will be V, 5, 4 & 3 / Fig 11 scoring will be V, 5, 4, 3
- Match 64 - Scoring on Fig 11 will be V, 5, 4 & 3
- Match 67 - Change from Falling Plates to 900 Deliberate (25mins/team) on a Fig 12(200M) on a 4 X 4 screen. Scoring V, V, 5, 4 on the Fig 12 only. All other hits on the 4X4 will score zero, but will be indicated
- Match 68 shall include the 900m CoF

Service Rifle

- Matches 2/3/4, 6/7/8 and 14/15/16 will be run in rapid succession (2 minutes between each match to re-load, confirm fall of shot & prepare for the next match);
- Match 2 - No sighters, (30 sec exp to see fall of shot), match scored in the butts
- Match 3 - No sighters, (30 sec exp to see fall of shot), match scored in the butts
- Match 6 - No sighters, (30 sec exp to see fall of shot), match scored in the butts
- Match 7 - No sighters, (30 sec exp to see fall of shot), match scored in the butts
- Match 14 - Fall of shot will be provided (30 sec exp to see fall of shot), match scored in the butts
- Match 15 - Fall of shot will be provided (30 sec exp to see fall of shot), match scored in the butts
- Match 17 - Moving Targets 300m - Fig 11; 200M - Fig 12; 100m - Fig 12; 50m - Fig 14. Match will commence 10M behind the 300m firing point and commence with a 15-second exposure to run up and adopt the prescribed position. Stages will run in rapid succession with 50 seconds to run 100 meters (stage 1-2 & 2-3) and 25 seconds to run 50 meters (Stage 3-4).
- a 30 second fall of shot will be provided for all snap and rapid matches immediately after the match and during the preparation period for the next match
